### Crime Overview

This section looks at the crimes of public interest that have occurred on the Rugby Rural South Safer Neighbourhood Team policing area. Below is a brief summary of some of the incidents that have been reported to us over the last month:

### Visit to Lynwood Stud Stables

### **Operation Nelson**



On the 13th August, Operation Nelson was conducted at the location with partner agencies to engage with the public around water safety. Attending agencies were, Rugby SNT, Tasking Team, Severn Trent Water, RLSA, Canal & River Trust, Draycote Rangers, Environment Agency (Fishery Enforcement), Wildlife Sanctuary, Rural Watch, Royal Marine Cadets, Warwickshire Cadets. Community engagement conducted about water safety and 68 bikes were coded. There were lots of visitors who came and chatted to us and lots of children

who enjoyed looking around and sitting in the police cars. A great day was had by all involved!

### **CMS - Community Messaging Service goes live!**

For the last few years, community groups, watch organisations and members of the public have used two separate email messaging systems that have reported incidents of interest and other community awareness messages. Replacing these and going live on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September is a new, single system, called the **Community Messaging Service (CMS)**.

The purpose of the new service is to streamline delivery of information to interested people and organisations that sign up, empowering and tasking individuals and local groups alike to pay specific attention in their respective areas when the police are in receipt of information that could assist them - to assist the police. The messages

and information is not only delivered directly via email to those who sign up, but can also be found on the each of the force's websites.

Chief Superintendent Lee Davenport said "The **Community Messaging Service** is an invaluable new tool which will allow us to quickly disseminate more urgent community messages as well as the publication of regular notices and newsletters. This service will better connect us to the public, and the public with their local policing teams. Communicating more effectively with our communities will help to reduce and prevent crime and help those most vulnerable."

Anyone interested in receiving information is encouraged to register and sign up; membership of a registered or recognised Watch scheme is not necessary. Signing up to the new **Community Messaging Service (CMS)** will mean the receipt of timely, localised information of interest, crime prevention advice or warnings of criminal activity.

The system has now launched and is already delivering messages to nearly 5,000 people who have already signed up via the force websites.
